# WHAT DO WE DO?



This year, a new criminal case has been released. As teams of 6-10 people, we prepare both sides of the case, select witnesses and craft opening statements, direct examinations, cross examinations, and closing arguments.

At tournaments, two teams from different universities compete, representing each side of the case - the Prosecution and the Defense.

Tournaments are typically 2-3 days, and each team will compete 4 rounds, each of which is 3 hours long.
